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HISTORY & PHYSICAL

Chief Complaint: "When will the diabetes go away?" Here for a well-check physical exam to participate in after-school basketball program.

Informant: Student/parent.

HPI: Timothy diagnosed with Diabetes Mellitus – Type 1 three weeks ago. Mother & Timothy attended diabetes education classes offered in MD's office – father has not received any diabetes care/management education.

PMX: Timothy is described by parent as a "healthy child." Normal delivery/birth. No accidents/injuries. No previous hospitalization or surgeries. Parents and 2 other older siblings in "good health."

DEVELOPMENTAL HX: Well-developed 9 y/o child with normal growth and development, milestones are normal for age. No deficits noted.

NUTRITIONAL HX: Parents report child has a "healthy appetite" and usually eats two meals a day with snacks. 18 percentile for height & weight; recent 1.8 kg. weight loss.

FAMILY HX: Benign. Both sets of grandparents and parents are alive and well. No other family history of diabetes.

IMMUNIZATIONS: Up-to-date including Hib (*H. influenza type B*)

ALLERGIES: No known drug allergies (NDKA).

Review of Systems

GENERAL: Well-developed 9-year-old male child.

SKIN: Benign, no history of rashes, lesions or easy bruising.

HEENT: Benign, no problems with vision, no ear or nasal problems.

RESPIRATORY: No history of asthma, croup, wheezing, shortness of breath or cough.

CARDIOVASCULAR: No history of congenital heart problems, murmurs, cyanosis, physical activity normal without shortness of breath on exertion.

GENITOURINARY: Within normal limits (WNL) for 9-year-old male child.

MUSCULOSKELETAL: Full range-of-motion (FROM). No deficits.

NEUROLOGIC: Intact & appropriate for age. Play appropriate for age, enjoys friends. Reportedly does well in school.

ENDOCRINE: Recently diagnosed with Diabetes Mellitus – Type 1.

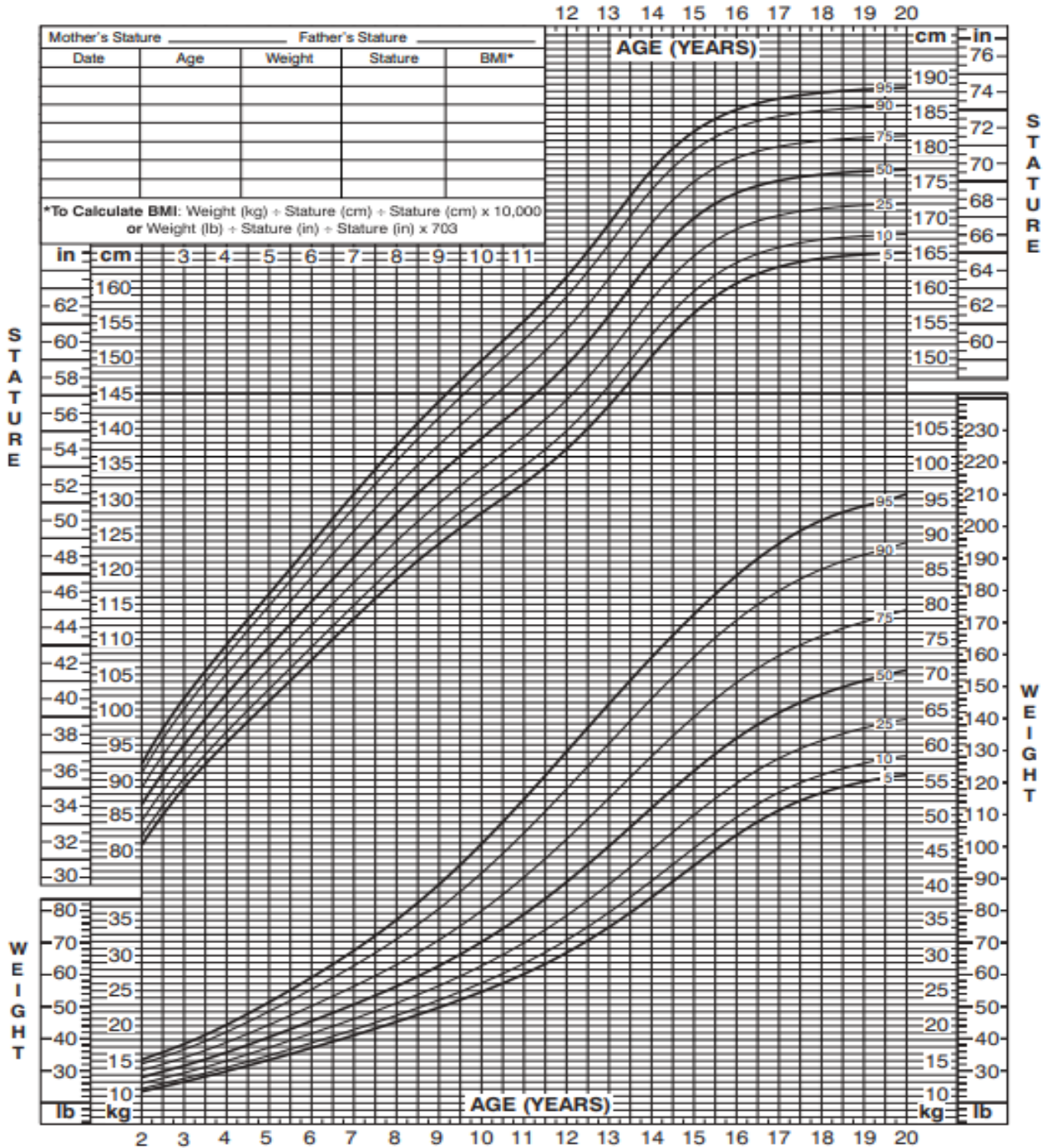
